Preserve the existing site and its database before replacing files. Upload into the document root for the selected domain.

Before you start

Use the access and features actually assigned to your account. Keep a rollback or recovery route before changing existing service settings.

Steps

1. Confirm the intended domain and document root in the hosting panel.
2. Create a recoverable copy of current files and any application database.
3. Upload through a supported encrypted method. Keep secret configuration and backups outside public web paths.
4. Test the homepage, internal links, HTTPS and relevant forms before treating the release as complete.

Verify the result

The correct domain shows the new release and a tested rollback copy remains available.
