Before you start

Use the access and features actually assigned to your account. Keep a rollback or recovery route before changing existing service settings.

Steps

1. Confirm that an instance has actually been provisioned and assigned to your account.
2. Obtain its approved address, operating system, login user and host-key fingerprint.
3. Keep a separate recovery path and backup destination before placing important data on it.
4. Complete networking, update and isolation checks before installing a customer workload.

Verify the result

The assigned instance and recovery route work. A product preview or image template is not a provisioned VPS.
